

CONVERSATIONS

You can have up to 15 conversations, and can switch between them by saying “Load conversation number [1-15].” Each conversation remembers its own history. You can also “delete conversation number [1-15]” and “start over.” Conversation 1 is always your “helpful assistant.”

Surprise Me!

If you're not sure what kind of role you want, let Tuxedo come up with one for you. After starting a new conversation, just say: “**Surprise me** [optional description].” Tuxedo will suggest a creative role — for example, “You're a time-traveling historian teaching me about the future.” When it asks “Where should we begin?”, you can either give it a starting prompt or say: “**Try again** [optional description].”

Continuous mode

If you don't want to keep saying the wake word say: “**Hey Tuxedo, turn on continuous mode.**” When enabled, Tuxedo will automatically listen for 10 seconds after each response, so you can keep the conversation going. You'll still need to say the wake word if you want to interrupt Tuxedo. Say “turn off continuous mode” to switch back.

Translation mode

Tuxedo can translate between languages. This feature is still experimental. Say “**Hey Tuxedo, translate to [Spanish, French, German, Portuguese, Chinese].**” Then whenever you say “Hey Tuxedo” followed by a phrase it will translate what you say to that language. To switch back say “Hey Tuxedo, switch back to conversation mode”.

KNOWN ISSUES / LIMITATIONS



- **False triggers.** Sometimes Tuxedo activates from background sounds that aren't directed at it. If this becomes a problem, you can say “Hey Tuxedo, turn listening off.” The LED will turn yellow to show that it's paused. Say “Hey Tuxedo, turn listening on” to turn listening back on.
- **Audio glitches.** Tuxedo may produce brief bursts of static or short audio dropouts. These should never last more than a few seconds.
- **Model limitations.** Tuxedo uses a compact on-device model. It's designed for creativity and conversation rather than factual accuracy. It may “hallucinate” or be inaccurate. Remember to always fact check.

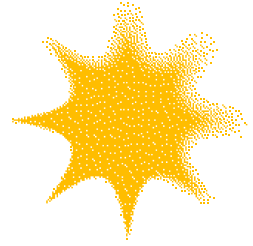
COMMANDS LIST

Tuxedo works best when you are facing the device and have an unobstructed view. For more info including video demos visit veku.ai/beta.

Conversations

After new conversation “please provide a role” say “surprise me [optional description]”, and after “where should we begin,” provide a prompt or say “try again [optional description].”

Other

- “Stop” or “Stop Talking”
- “Can you regenerate that?”
- “Can you repeat that?”
- Turn listening [on/off]
- Turn continuous mode [on/off]
- Translate to [Spanish, French, Chinese, Russian, German, Portuguese, Italian]
- Change the voice
- Turn the volume [up/down]
- Set the volume to [1-100]
- Run the Software Update (flash drive plugged in with an update)
- Copy [all my data, the default data, usage statistics] to the hard drive (flash drive plugged in)

OPERATION

Status LED

- Solid White - waiting for you to say “Hey Tuxedo”
- Blue - Listening to your input
- Moving White - Loading
- Yellow - Listening disabled (see Known Issues)
- Green - Device in translation mode
- Light Blue - Device in continuous mode
